

## **UPHOLSTERY CARE**

- Regular vacuuming of your upholstered furniture will enhance the beauty and longevity of your fabric.
- Treat spills promptly. GENTLY BLOT away spill with a clean, dry absorbent cloth. DO NOT RUB.
- Attempt removal of dried contaminants with a soft brush or dull knife prior to using a wet treatment.

**IMPORTANT!** TEST A SMALL HIDDEN SECTION OF THE UPHOLSTERY TO ENSURE FABRIC AND COLOR ARE NOT AFFECTED. FOR SEVERE STAINS, CONSULT A PROFESSIONAL UPHOLSTERY CLEANER.

## **CLEANING METHODS**

While all stains may not be completely removed, these methods are suggested for best results.

- A Use a water-based soap solution of 1 tablespoon of laundry detergent per 2 cups of warm water. Dampen the cleaning cloth and GENTLY BLOT away the spill. DO NOT RUB. Rotate the cleaning cloth often and rinse with water to ensure complete removal of all soap residue.
- B Use a mild solvent-based residential upholstery cleaner and follow the manufacturer's instructions.

## DYE TRANSFER POLICY

Dye transfer, particularly from denim can occur on light colored fabrics. While Neverfear® will withstand most types of dyes, due to the inability to control what materials our fabrics are exposed to, Z-Wovens will not assume responsibility for dye transfer.

CONTAMINANT	CLEANING METHOD (SEE ABOVE)
Chocolate, Coffee, Tea, Juice	A with tepid water
Fruit	A with cold water
Ink	A with rubbing alcohol
Milk, Wine, Soft Drinks	A
Grease, Oil, Lipstick	В
Wax	Brush first, then B
Vomit	Lift with cold water sponge, then A
Urine	A
Pencil	B followed by A
Mud	Lift off, vacuum, then A
